#The Elegie, written in 1918 by Sir Charles Hubert Hastings Parry, has only recently been discovered 100 years after his death by Dr. Jonathan Clinch. It was Parry's last original composition and reflects his sense of grief at losing so many talented students at the Royal College of Music in the Great War. This work was premiered at the Royal Festival Hall on Tuesday 24th April and is published by the RCM.
